THE MIDDLE CLASS IS UNDER ATTACK!

On March 9, the state Senate passed the emergency managers bills. The legislation will let Governor Snyder's hand-picked appointees terminate collective bargaining agreements. The managers will also have the power to remove our elected officials and dissolve our city councils, school boards and other political structures. This is an egregious assault on our democratic freedoms and our right to form unions.

On March 1, the Michigan Department of Human Services announced it will end the Michigan Home Based Child Care Council. This is another blatant attempt to silence the voice of child care providers, who are among the lowest paid workers in the state.



GOVERNOR SNYDER'S BUDGET WILL HAVE A DEVASTATING IMPACT ON MICHIGAN FAMILIES.

- It puts a tax on pension checks, making it that much harder for seniors to make ends meet.
- It demands \$180 million in additional wage and benefit concessions from state employees.
- It eliminates the Earned Income Tax Credit, which will plunge thousands of working families into poverty.
- It makes deep cuts in public education, which will severely impact the our children ability to learn.

To make matters worse, the governor's budget will take the savings from these cuts to hand out **\$1.7 billion in tax cuts for corporations.** This is unacceptable!
