The Wentzville Assembly Plant has been slated to go down on 5/24/2021 thru 7/19/2021. There is scheduled to be an 8-week shut down for Wentzville Assembly, yet with the unpredictability of the status of other assembly plants that we supply, the numbers are constantly changing. At the publishing of this newsletter, the timing of layoffs to start have been projected as early as 5/10/2021. As I stated earlier, many factors out of our control are in play where we are reacting as they occur, and everything is subject to change.
