- Scan QR or go to the App or Play Store
- Select UAW Local 2209
- Register (you must enter a password that contains an uppercase letter, a number, and a symbol)
- Once the app is open, click "Let's Go"
- Select the 3 dots in the upper right corner
- Edit My profile
- Manage Profile
- Select "My Tags"
- UAW 2209 select organization
- Edit
- Select all tags that apply to your membership in UAW Local 2209. Admins will have to approve each tag you select
