### ANNUAL EXEMPTION OF OVERTIME

### GENERAL INCREASE

September 19<sup>th</sup> seniority employees will receive a 3% wage increase, those seniority employees in wage progression will continue to receive their increase (52 weeks worked) according to the wage progression chart. This information can be found in the National agreement pages 79 & 80 paragraph 98 A&B, and in progression page 243 & 244 Memorandum of understanding UAW-Gm wage & benefit agreement.

The third party has collected their samples and we should have the results by the end of the week, we will communicate results when we receive them.


**SAFETY WEEK**


