<u>Grievances</u> – 255 13 – discharges

<u>Hot patching</u> – March 20th there will be a group doing hot patch repairs in front of the plant and will move to the south entrance, please be mindful as you drive through the entrances.

<u>Production/Overtime Schedule</u> – We are on a 9-hour schedule for Assembly and Stamping. All Previously Scheduled Production Saturdays are cancelled.

Fairfax Stamping will announce any overtime other than scheduled production Saturdays to support Fairfax production.

Local negotiation – As to date we have 5 open issues between the UAW and GM, three (3) Union and two (2) management.

ATTENTION SAP UPDATE

3/14 Update from International UAW regarding SAP.

<u>2024 Phase 1 SAP Highlights</u> Enrollment will be handled by HR/LR (Labor Dept.)

- The enrollment window will be <u>March 23rd, 2024, through May 6th, 2024, (11:59</u> <u>central.</u>)
- You will need to fill out forms A & B provided by HR/LR during the enrollment window noted above.
- Labor relations will conduct roll out meetings on <u>March 19th @ 7am for 3rd shift</u>, <u>3pm for 2nd shift and 4:15pm for 1st shift in the plant auditorium</u>. UAW Local 31 Benefit reps will be in attendance to help with Q&A.
- We highly encourage all interested production and skilled trades employees to enroll during this phase 1 enrollment window, regardless of whether you think you will fall into the 2%. This will show management the extreme interest and energy we have concerning the agreed upon contractual language regarding the SAP.
- Two percent of our total production workforce at Fairfax assembly & Stamping manufacturing will be eligible during phase 1.
- Two percent of our total skilled trades workforce at Fairfax assembly & Stamping manufacturing will be eligible during phase 1.

Division I and Division II – <u>Applicants will be determined by your longest continu-</u> ous service date!!!

- Within 7 days after the enrollment window closes, HR/LR will notify those that are eligible to retire under the agreed upon phase 1 SAP.
- Those who are eligible have 7 days from signing forms A & B with HR/LR to **re-voke** interest. HR/LR must be notified of this decision.
- Those who qualify will be notified by HR/LR of their retirement date, which will be June 1st, 2024. July 1st, 2024, or August 1st, 2024.
